Inside shoes need to be non-marking running shoes. Your child needs to be able to put them on all by themselves. No shoes with laces if your child cannot do them without help.



REPORTING STUDENT ABSENCES WITH SAFE ARRIVAL:

Report student absences online

The Abbotsford School District utilizes an automated student attendance management system called SafeArrival, offered through SchoolMessenger®, the company that hosts our parent notification system.

With SafeArrival, you can report your child's absence in advance using any of these 3 convenient methods:

1. **SchoolMessenger App**

Using your mobile device, download and install the SchoolMessenger app from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store.

The first time you use the app, select Sign Up to create your account.

Select Attendance then Report an Absence.

2. **SafeArrival Website**

Using the SafeArrival website, go to: <http://go.schoolmessenger.ca>

The first time you use the website, select Sign Up to create your account.

Select Attendance then Report an Absence.

3. **Toll-Free Number**

Call 1-844-487-3701 to report an absence using the automated phone system.

These options are available 24 hours/day, 7 days a week. Future absences can be reported at any time.

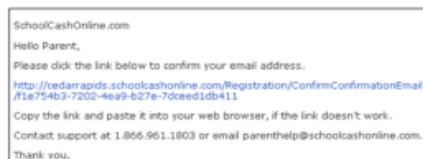

A registration confirmation email will be forwarded to you. Click on the link provided inside the email to confirm your email and School Cash Online account.

The confirmation link will open the School Cash Online site prompting you to sign into your account. Use your email address and password just created with your account.

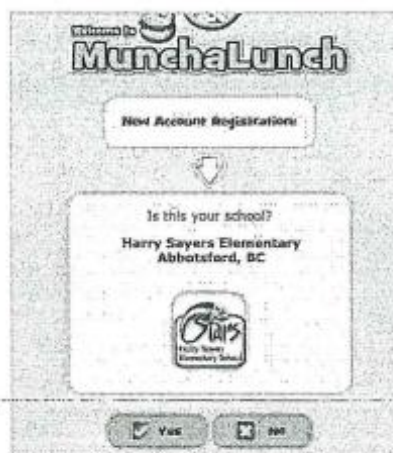

VOLUNTEERING INFORMATION:

If you are interested in volunteering in your child's classroom, helping on field trips, or in our school for special events, you must obtain criminal record check clearance (see process below).

The Ministry of Justice regulations require any volunteer who comes near or works around children to complete a criminal record check, regardless of the time spent working near or around them. This requirement involves a Criminal Record Search, valid for 5 years, which includes a Vulnerable Sector Search.

Steps to become a volunteer:

1. Pick up a volunteer package at our school office. Please fill out the Volunteer Application Form and Confidentiality Understanding Form. Return them to the school office. These forms need to be completed annually.
2. Have your criminal record check processed (see below).

Criminal Record Check Process:

Interested volunteers must go to the School Board Office to complete a criminal record check (there is no cost).

You will be asked to provide 2 pieces of I.D. (primary and secondary I.D.) to verify yourself along with your criminal record consent form. The district's authorized contact submits the form to the CRRP for processing and will advise our school of the results once they are received. At this time, you can start volunteering.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES:

From the Abbotsford School District Website:

In the event of an emergency, schools can be placed under one of four 'emergency actions' or statuses to ensure the security and safety of students and employees:

- Drop, Cover and Hold
- Evacuation
- Shelter in Place
- Lockdown

Reasons for such closures could include bomb threats, gas leaks, fire, smoke, power failure, extreme weather situations, earthquakes and other causes that may endanger students and staff. Our Emergency Procedures are put into place by either a school administrator (Principal, Vice-Principal, or if neither available, the Teacher-in-Charge), Assistant Superintendent or the Superintendent. The Superintendent is responsible for all decisions relating to school closures. Information regarding each level of emergency status is listed in our Administrative Procedure 103 - Emergency Procedures. Procedures are practiced at each school at multiple times through the year. In all scenarios, special considerations are to be taken by teachers and supervisors for the care and evacuation of students with special needs.
